VISUAL TREE ASSESSMENT / COMMENTS

The applicants submitted a tree work application (3/2018/0286) in April 2018 with a report carried out by a qualified Arboricultural Consultant and subsequent approved pruning works carried out by a fully qualified arborist which is the correct process. Please see photograph below.



In May 2023 the same landowners did neither of the above and the tree was mutilated by an unqualified person, please see photograph below.



Unfortunately the Council was unable to pursue formal action against the unauthorised works, however due to the devastating pruning, the tree has lost the majority of its amenity value and a TPO cannot be justified.
