

Noise Assessment

There is no building or development work happening so there will be noise in the set up of the salon. It's already set up.

The salon itself, when open as a business will create minimal noise. There may be the potential for dog barking when I'm grooming a dog but this will be controlled and the dog distracted to minimise noise. If a dog is particularly noisy, the groom will be cancelled and that dog won't be accepted again.

The only other potential for noise is the blaster/dryer. The dryer i have has a noise muffler to keep the noise to a minimum. It's no louder than a normal hairdryer and can't be heard outside when the salon doors are closed.
