With regard to your consultation letter dated 25 June 2025, I have the following comments to make based on all the information provided by the applicant to date.

No objection

Lancashire County Council acting as the Local Highway Authority does not raise an objection regarding the proposed development and are of the opinion that the proposed development will not have a significant impact on highway safety or capacity in the immediate vicinity of the site.

The Local Highway Authority (LHA) are in receipt of a retrospective application for the proposed replacement agricultural livestock building which has been previously demolished.

The LHA is aware that the site access will remain unaltered following the proposal; the access and internal road also serve Public Right of Way FP0312038.

The proposal results in the removal of an existing 1240.18m2 agricultural building and replacing it with a 1185.33m2 agricultural building, which will continue to be used to house livestock within the farm. The LHA are of the view that the proposal will have a negligible impact on the surrounding highway network.
