

Prior notification of extension to existing Agri building to form hay and straw storage

Land off Longridge Road hurst green bb7 9qp

Amount

One agricultural building measuring 4.57m long, 10m wide, 4.6m to eaves, and 6m to the ridge. The building will be adjoining the northern gable end of existing building

location

the proposed building will be on a 32-acre block of grassland located off longridge rd, separated from the main farmstead, Grindlestone, by the highway.

Scale/ appearance

The building will be small in scale and will only be one additional bay on existing building, resulting in the volume of the building being no larger than other single agriculture buildings in the area. It will have natural grey cement fibre roof sheets, pre stressed concrete panels at the base of the walls topped off with Yorkshire board cladding.

Use

The building is required to provide dry storage for winter feed produced on this parcel of land. Being able to store hay and straw inside will reduce losses Previously feed has spoiled as a result of being stored outside, we then have to purchase extra bought in feed to make up for the losses. I need to be able to store approx. 25-30 tons of hay and straw with would require a floor space of 40-45m² stacked to a height of 4.5m.
