It has come to our notice that our Mr and Mrs Fenn of Riverside Lodge, Sawley have submitted a further application to fell more trees in their garden.

The two trees concerned on this latest application are mature healthy trees which are visible from many public spaces around the conservation area. The conifer described as small in the application is actually around 8 meters tall. they are regularly full of birds.

The protected view from Sawley bridge would be altered significantly by the felling of these trees. In addition to losing them from the landscape, our home, Park House, which is not currently visible within that view, would immediately be totally exposed.

Many healthy trees have already been felled to facilitate the planned building works, and to improve the [REDACTED] a previous application, and it would be very sad to lose any more.

We sincerely hope that the cumulative effect of all the applications which Mr and Mrs Fenn are drip feeding through the planning system will be considered as a whole. Lots of seemingly modest changes can add up to a complete transformation which really should not be acceptable within a conservation area.
