Further to [REDACTED] and my letter of objection to the above planning application, attached please find photograph images of a stationary bus obstructing the road outside Bowland Country Park taken at 12.39pm on Saturday June 20th 2026 at the time other guests were seen arriving for a wedding at the venue. Signs on the road to the park indicated the wedding was the [REDACTED]. After sitting in a queue of traffic I eventually managed to get past the stationary bus by driving onto the entrance of Bowland Country Park. This wasn't overly safe due to lack of visibility of oncoming traffic.

This highlights the lack of suitability of the park as a wedding venue.
