However, the Buildings Committee of the Victorian Society wishes to highlight the level of maintenance that Solar Panels need to remain safe. They can represent a fire risk to historic buildings if not properly maintained, and in the proposed location for these panels, adequate roof access would be required for this level of maintenance.

The Committee advises your Authority to see that this maintenance is ensured before the pv panels are granted permission.
