



The proposal is to create four holiday lodges that integrate and blend seamlessly with the landscape character of the site and the wider landscape area. The utilisation of natural materials and naturalistic ecology types drove the design of the landscape. This was to ensure that the agrarian character and local vernacular were maintained and enhanced.

Significant ecological enhancements are proposed from the improvement of the agricultural grassland ecology type and introduction of native species hedgerow swaths and native species trees.

The Public Right of Way (PRoW) has also been improved through proposed robust surfacing and connection to the new site access track.

Large communal amenity spaces have also been created to provide shared seating and leisure areas.
