I object strongly to the proposed development Salesbury View, planning application 3/2025/0801

I wish to bring to your attention this morning, temperatures of -9 and the proposed entry / exit road for the Salesbury view site.

I was sat in stationary traffic; after taking my [REDACTED], I queued from Langho to Brownhill, it took 55mins to travel a few miles at peak time. It was chaotic. When I reached the proposed entry / exit site for salesbury view I sat in my car terrified, watching as another car repeatedly attempted to drive up the road to the proposed new houses, the car was skidding, sliding from side to side on the ice and then sliding backwards down the road towards parked cars and towards traffic that was moving in the opposite direction. The person driving had no vehicular control due to the adverse road conditions. The car could not drive up the hill. I sat and prayed nobody attempted to drive down, if they did, they would not have been able to stop and would have driven into oncoming traffic. The car abandoned its attempts, to the relief of myself and I'm sure the other drivers. The council planners and proposed developers should have been there to witness and watch. The road is seriously not safe for vehicular access. Residents from neighbouring properties leave their cars parked on the main road; there were no spaces left on the main road in which to park a car. If planning is passed where would these residents leave their cars if they cannot drive up to their homes. If they attempted to leave, they would endanger themselves and those using the main road.

I propose the road be monitored at peak times this week and when snow & ice is forecast, if witnessed no one would deem the road safe to use as access to a housing estate.
