Subject: Salisbury view plan objection

I would like to register a second objection to the new plans for the salesbury view housing development.

It has come to my attention that there is serious concern about the new plans for the style of houses to be built and most significantly the plan for the drainage and the picture showing where the pipes where being laid on Salesbury view.

Persimmon amended application is showing that they have found water pipes so there is no objection from United utilities. However they still say the pipes run East to west, when in fact they start running from North to South.

It appears they may have entered the field and found pipes running towards Salesbury view but haven't gone any further than that. Given that Persimmon are clearly desperate to get the application passed and started presumably they will change the layout then because of the pipes as they are not allowed to build over water mains. Therefore if the building has to be changed from the plan because of this mistake then the plans are incorrect and therefore void and the planning committee should not pass the plans.

The residents of Wilpshire have objected on this site for building many times and for good reasons: local facilities, drainage, access, etc and yet despite this the council still continues on with there plans. I would ask you to put the concerns and wishes of the local people first on this issue.
