

Water Efficiency Statement

July 2023

Land east of Salisbury View, Wiltshire

The current Part G of the building regulations covers water efficiency in new homes and sets the standard for per capita consumption as:

- Standard: 125 litres per person per day
- Optional: 110 litres per person per day in areas where local planning authorities have this as a requirement in planning permission based on their assessment of being in an area of water stress

Ribble Valley lies within the remit of United Utilities (UU). The company area covered by UU is deemed to be an area not seriously water stressed. Classification map overleaf (Environment Agency).

All new Persimmon Homes will meet and exceed the required building regulation standard.
