1. Introduction

The site at Braeside was subject to general clearance works prior to Habitat Architecture Ltd being appointed. At the time of our commission, the area had already been tidied and opened up to allow for a better understanding of site levels, boundaries, and existing conditions.

None of the trees removed were within protected areas or covered by Tree Preservation Orders to our knowledge, and the works undertaken were limited to site clearance of overgrown vegetation and surface debris. These works were carried out solely to facilitate access and visibility for the purpose of design development and site appraisal.

All subsequent design and planning proposals have been based on the cleared condition of the site as it was presented to us at the commencement of our appointment.
