1. The opening hours stated on the application are the restaurant dining times, do they ask everyone to leave and close up at 8.30pm on Friday and Saturday nights, if they remain open longer they would be in breach of planning.
2. To satisfy access arrangements informal laybys have been provided, what do they mean by informal?
3. Previously Gazegill were advertising as a wedding venue. This will result in a higher traffic volume and will presumably lead to later hours opening. Is this no longer proposed or will they be applying for an extension for each event?
