Comments: [REDACTED] strongly object to this planning application as we have lived on this road for over [REDACTED] years and have noticed an increase in traffic and pollution from the site which is already extremely busy both during the day and at night. To access the site vehicles would only be able to use the A666 Road as the road from the A59 to Carr Hall has a railway bridge with a height restriction. The A666 is used by the local bus to deliver both school children and shoppers to their Ribble Valley destination. Whalley Road is also the main road for the ambulance service to get to people who need emergency care. Unfortunately this road also is used for high speed drivers. There is already a number of large buildings on site which the developer has used over the years for a number of unsuccessful business developments and feel that it is not necessary for any more buildings/weighbridges to be built on this land which will impact on the surrounding environment and also the local wildlife in that area.
