Many thanks for your note below.

To confirm, I would still like to go ahead with the following points of concern:

1. Noise impacts due to increased vehicle movements as they will be processing and moving approx. 16,000 eggs per day off the property. This will be an industrial, commercial site and is not a minor commercial application.
2. Increased odour levels and air quality due to high ammonia levels and increased risk to the natural environment due to increased nitrogen. This will also result in increased flies and therefore we will no longer be able to [REDACTED]. Water pollution may become an increased issue.
3. Impact on public health – the spread of bird flu in our neighbourhood with so many birds being present.
4. Negative impact on roads – there is not the infrastructure in place to support lorries, trucks and increased number of large farm vehicles on our small lanes.
5. The visual impact on the landscape.
