














**Existing**

-  **Trees**  
All trees to be retained shall be protected in accordance with BS 5837:2012
-  **Bark chipping paths**

**Proposed**

-  **Existing building extended**  
Building structure to be extended to accommodate wellness areas
-  **Existing paving extended**  
Existing paving surrounding building to be extended to accommodate areas around the new extension
-  **Paths**  
New paths from existing building and extension to provide level surface to connect to outdoor pool area
-  **Pool terrace**  
To be natural effect composite deck boards
-  **Natural swimming pool**  
Two primary zones: a swimming zone and a filtration zone. Water is circulated between zones continually to provide biological filtration using planted gravel beds, mineral substrates, and biofilms. Aquatic and marginal plants selected for nutrient uptake, oxygenation and ecological benefit
-  **Native species trees**  
New multistem, feathered and standard trees to provide screening and shelter to pool area
-  **Native species hedgerows**  
Hedgerow species to be planted informally to create natural screen to pool area and create ecological benefit
-  **Naturalistic planting**  
Low level native planting to provide shelter to pool area and create ecological benefit
-  **Species rich grass**  
Softer grass areas to provide ecological benefit
