Thank you for forwarding this.

For clarification, the class referred to on Tuesday evening took place within the existing gym cardio area, which already benefits from the necessary permissions and has previously undergone and passed an official sound assessment at considerable expense.

However, I appreciate that the resident is clearly concerned about noise and may understandably be paying particular attention to activity at the site during the planning process. Whilst I do not believe a single class per week within an already permitted building represents a significant issue, I am keen to avoid any unnecessary delays or requests for further reports.

Therefore, as a gesture of goodwill, I am willing to cease using a microphone during this one weekly class in order to address the resident's concerns and demonstrate our commitment to being considerate neighbours.
