VISUAL TREE ASSESSMENT / COMMENTS

The removal of trees specified in the application is required to protect life and property because of declining and progressive crown retrenchment/vitality and reduced safe useful life expectancy. However, because of the extent and density of the tree cover throughout Shireburne park the tree work will have relatively limited impact on the visual amenity value of tree scape in both the wider and local context. Shireburne park has an extensive density of tree cover much of which is at least 90% dense woodland as such replacement planting is not deemed necessary or achievable in this instance.
