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Dear Planning Officer,

I am writing to express my concerns regarding the planning application for the proposed change of use of my neighbour's garage.

I wish to object to this application on the grounds that I believe it will have a negative impact on parking in our area. At present, the applicants do not appear to use their garage or driveway for parking their vehicles, with cars frequently being parked on the road instead.

Our road is already very busy, and on-street parking is limited. I am concerned that converting the garage to another use would permanently remove a parking space and could result in even more vehicles being parked on the street. This would add to existing parking pressures, create additional inconvenience for residents, and could potentially affect road safety and access along what is already a busy main road.

I would appreciate it if these concerns could be taken into consideration when assessing the application, particularly in relation to the impact on parking provision and the wider effect on neighbouring properties and the local area.
