Dear Sir/Madam,

Please accept this letter as confirmation of the proposed acoustic insulation scheme for the commercial unit located at 29-33 Berry Lane, Longridge.

The proposed works are intended to ensure that internally generated noise from the premises does not adversely impact the residential properties situated above and adjoining the unit.

The proposed acoustic installation system is designed to improve sound insulation between the commercial premises and the residential accommodation above. The works may include the installation of acoustic mineral wool insulation within the ceiling void, suspended acoustic ceiling systems, acoustic plasterboard, acoustic sealants, and resilient acoustic bar systems to help reduce airborne noise and vibration transfer through the building structure.

Additional acoustic insulation and acoustic boarding may also be installed to adjoining walls where required. Decorative acoustic wall panels and, if necessary, acoustic ceiling panels are also proposed throughout the premises to improve sound absorption, reduce echo, and minimise internal sound reverberation within the unit.

These acoustic treatment measures are intended to reduce airborne noise, vibration transfer, and internal reverberation to ensure neighbouring residential properties are protected from noise disturbance.

All sound insulation works will be designed and installed to ensure that internal noise levels within the residential properties comply with the recommendations contained within BS8233:2014 – Guidance on Sound Insulation and Noise Reduction for Buildings.

The sound insulation measures will be fully implemented prior to the premises becoming operational and will be maintained thereafter to ensure continued compliance.

Please find attached photographic examples of the proposed acoustic insulation systems, suspended ceiling treatments, resilient acoustic bar systems, and decorative acoustic wall panels intended to demonstrate the type of soundproofing measures proposed within the premises.

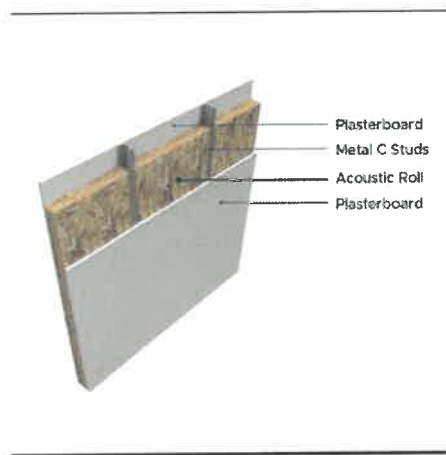
