I am writing to express my strong support for the planning application to construct a community pump track at the Edisford Riverbank site. This facility represents a highly positive, forward-thinking use of an under-utilised space and will deliver significant benefits to Clitheroe:

Promotes Free, Inclusive Health and Wellbeing: Unlike traditional sports pitches, a pump track requires no membership fees or organized teams. It provides an "outdoor gym" accessible to all generations—from toddlers on balance bikes to teenagers and adults on bikes, scooters, and skateboards—encouraging active, healthy lifestyles.

Fills a Crucial Gap for Youth Provision: While Clitheroe is well-served for toddler play areas, there is a distinct lack of free, positive outdoor spaces for teenagers. This track offers an excellent, constructive outlet for young people, fostering a sense of community ownership and naturally reducing anti-social behavior through active engagement.

An All-Weather, Sustainable Asset: The proposed asphalt design is durable, low-maintenance, and usable year-round, unlike grass pitches that suffer from seasonal waterlogging. Placing it within the existing Edisford recreational hub creates a fantastic multi-activity destination for local families.

Reduces Out-of-Borough Travel: Currently, local riders must travel to facilities in neighboring boroughs by car. Providing a high-quality track locally allows young people to travel independently by foot or bike, supporting local climate and sustainable transport goals.

This project is a fantastic use of the UK Shared Prosperity Fund and will deliver an invaluable health and social asset to the people of Clitheroe. I fully urge the planning committee to approve this application.
