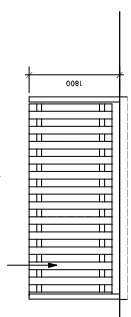


These studies are not the only studies that report that a population of information that is not shared by all members of a group may be used to predict the behavior of the group as a whole. For example, in a study of the effects of group size on the performance of a group of students, it was found that the performance of a group of students was significantly better than the performance of a group of students who were not in the same group (Bass, 1980). This finding is important to the study of group dynamics.

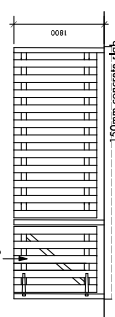
REFUSE RECYCLING/BIN STORE AND CYCLE STORAGE

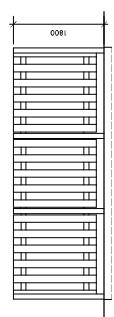


B proposed elevation

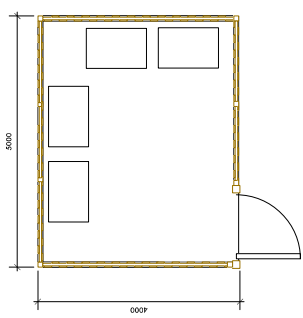

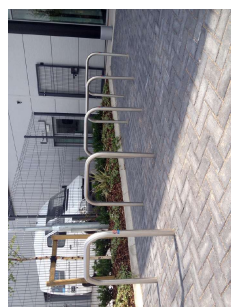


D proposed elevation
