comments: I object to this application on the following grounds: 1. Unjustified demolition of housing stock suitable for affordable housing at a time when the British Government claims the UK has a housing shortage. 2. The proposed building of 50 properties is too high a density for that area. 3. There is a proposed closure of a long established Right of Way adjoining the development site. 4. Queen Mary Terrace and Bridge Terrace, as the names imply, are arguably of historic importance, being part of the former Queen Mary Military Hospital which served injured soldiers from WW1, many who now lie in the War Graves Cemetery directly opposite. 5.
