Windows 6,7,8,7A and 11 are early 19th C openings in plain masonry openings.

Windows 5,9,10 and 12 are late 19th C modified openings.

Windows 5 and 9 are late 19th C openings with 2 over 2 sash with horns, typical of the period.

W10 and W12 contain improvised 20th C casements.

Windows 1-4

Windows 1-4 are tripartite windows with early 19th C 4-over-4 sash and late 19th C 1 over 1 side panes.

The original 4/4 sash are heavily decayed and warrant renewal; the side panes are capable of restoration. East side pane to W3 is decayed and should be renewed.



Early 19th C glazing bar to 4/4 sash

Poor, heavily decayed. Renewal is warranted.
