I am writing in regards to the proposed planning of 123 new homes on Higher Road, Longridge.  
Application 3/2021/0556

Have the plans been approved?

The majority of Longridge residents have reasonably objected these plans due to the lack of infrastructure. Residents are not able to obtain doctors or dentist appointments. The roads of longridge are unable to cope at the moment, never mind with another 200+ cars the proposed development will bring. In previous years there has been no talk of new schools being built to support the children whom move and are born here.

Wildlife is another big factor which will be impacted greatly, the land proposed is farm land and should remain so. The loss of biodiversity due to the new houses will be detrimental to the biodiversity already lost!

There are currently 8 new build sites in development in Longridge currently. 1 being unfinished and left in a dire state, it is obscured to consider another at this moment in time.
