Re. The above planning application for the refurbishment & extension of The Buck Inn Sawley Road Grindleton.

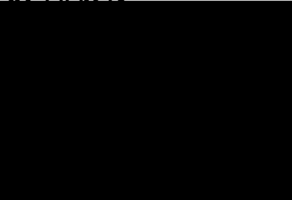
I fully support this planning application as a new resident to the area since May this year.
