I would like to object to the proposed Dining Pod at The Lord Nelson Application reference 3/2021/0825 on the following grounds:

- as a local resident I am concerned about increased noise pollution that would be created within the quiet residential location
- the design of the Dining Pod is not in keeping with the aesthetic of the Lord Nelson and is out of character for a building of that age
- there is currently limited parking available for customers of the Lord Nelson, the Dining Pod will exacerbate the issue causing congestion issues to the local residents and potential danger of increased parking and pedestrians on Whalley Old Road.
