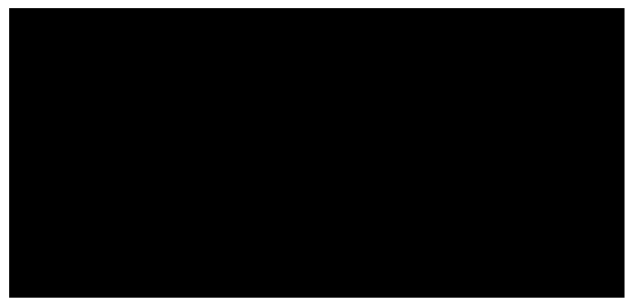
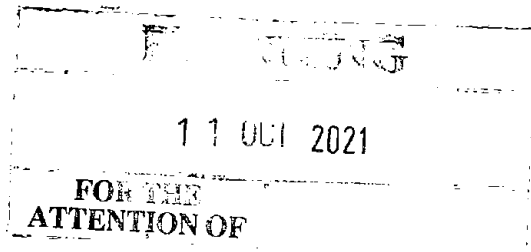




Dear Mr. Machole,

Thank you for your letter inviting comments on the above, second, application to extend a bungalow on the street where I live. I can only reiterate my previous concerns about the inappropriate nature of the plans: this is a 1960's development of mostly bungalows. The few two-storey houses have bigger plots than the bungalows, and therefore do not seem to be oppressively close to their neighbours. No. 3 would not pass that test. This application is no better than the previous attempt, which was turned down recently. It perplexes me that someone who wants a

house buys a bungalow, and then accuses the neighbours of being obstructive, when they are merely attempting to preserve their neighbourhood. The Ribble Valley is short of bungalows, in spite of having an above-average number of oldies living here. I urge you to use your influence to persuade the decision-makers to be consistent, and again turn down a completely unsuitable application.
