OBJECTION

[REDACTED] This wall forms part of the original construction of the house and dates back to the late 1800's. The proposed extension plans indicate the removal of this ancient wall to be replaced by the extension with a rendered side.

The proposal states it will be in keeping with other extensions with neighbouring properties, this is in fact incorrect, not one single property between the proposer number 6 and the end of the terraced row number 42 has had a side extension with complete infill to the adjoining party wall.

Due to the North facing rear and subsequent sun position the rear rooms of these properties are already extremely dark due to a lack of light and it is common for us to have a light on in the rear rooms even in the summer months during daytime hours. The proposed plans show that the extension will have a full length patio door on the rear in addition to a staggering 5 velux type windows, that in itself indicates the need to get light into the property.
