Your Comments: With regard to the planning application for nets at Clitheroe Golf Club we believe this proposal should not go ahead for the following reasons:

The balls which are occasionally launched high over the wood are potentially dangerous. However, these would not be stopped by these nets. Safety nets need to be much closer to the first tee and placed in such a way as to curb any errant balls. In place of nets why not place sand bunkers along the side of the hole that runs parallel to the houses as that would in turn make the golfer refrain from aiming that way.

The nets would also have a negative effect on the wildlife as there are many birds which can be spotted feeding and nesting in the trees next to the house.

In conclusion we are very concerned that the nets will have such a negative impact on many species of birds, bats and other wildlife and habitats.
