Your Comments: I wish to state my opposition to the 5.8m safety net proposed by Clitheroe Golf Club.

-Whilst our property is not affected by errant golf balls, the proposed safety net would be very visible from the front windows and would impair our view of the trees and sunset; and potentially negatively impacting upon the aspect and value of our property.

-The density of the proposed safety fence is such that the natural light available in the evenings will be reduced. This may impact adversely on the mental health of the residents (availability of bright light being strongly linked to serotonin production and depression).

-I am concerned about the adverse impact of the proposed fence on the wildlife, their habitat and the ecosystem. I see no reference to this in the risk assessment or any of the other documents so presume that there has been no consideration of this.
