**Your Comments:** I live at [REDACTED]. Although our house doesn't back onto the golf course we have had several balls land in our side garden/drive. This is a huge safety issue. There is a clearing in the trees behind the single storey garage of number 9 (which we face side on) and therefore there seems to be a clear path for balls to come into the estate towards our house. I am hugely concerned about the chance a stray ball could cause serious injuries. I'm therefore in favour of any safety measures which reduce this risk, including these nets. I would have liked to see the nets extended towards the tee position to reduce this risk further but I do accept this netting would stop some balls from entering the estate from certain positions on the course (for example golfers mid way between the tee and the green).
