I am writing with concern to Route 1 of the application (No 3/20210660. I live [REDACTED] in Chatburn, [REDACTED]. At present it can be difficult to enter [REDACTED] due to the width of the road and quite a number of parked cars [REDACTED]. If a car is coming in the other direction once you are on [REDACTED] it can result in at least one of the cars having to mount the pavement so they can pass. If this proposal goes through it would be absolute chaos and will, I am sure, lead to an accident.

This part of the proposal is only half the problem, once [REDACTED] has been negotiated there is the very narrow road leading to Grindleton bridge (which is also narrow) with further problems in West Bradford and out again on the other side.

Route 2 of the application takes out at least ¾ of the problems. The last section through Waddington (if the application goes through) cannot be avoided which ever route is approved, and I feel sorry for the people of Waddington who will have to put up with this for at least 6 years.
