
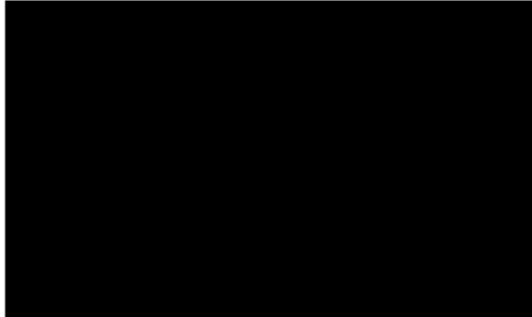

We have received the notice in relation to the above planning application.

Firstly, we want to be reasonable [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] You are aware that an outbuilding was erected recently. [REDACTED] to speak to [REDACTED] with a view to moving the building out of [REDACTED] once we became aware of the application. In that circumstance, it was erected without mitigation. Ribble Valley Borough Council obviously concluded that there was at the very least a short term need for the building for [REDACTED] to sheep farm. We accept that.
