House, formerly 2, probably late C18th. Slobbered watershot rubble with slate roof. 2 storeys, 2 bays. Windows modern with glazing bars and plain reveals. Between the bays are 2 doors with plain reveals, the right-hand one now partly blocked to form a window. End stacks. Listed for group value only.

The Coach and Horses Public House

Public house, late C18th. Squared watershot limestone with hipped slate roof. The main part of the facade is a symmetrical composition of 2 storeys and 3 bays, with chamfered quoins. The windows are sashed with glazing bars in plain stone surrounds. The central door has 6 raised and fielded panels and a plain stone surround with semi-circular head and a fanlight with radiating glazing bars. Set back to the right is a further bay, with similar window details and with punched quoins.

Chadwick's Farmhouse

House, early C19th. Squared coursed sandstone with stone slate roof. Double-pile plan with end stacks. 2 storeys, 2 bays. Windows tripartite with plain stone surrounds and square mullions. On the ground floor they are sashed with glazing bars. On the 1st floor sashed with no glazing bars. The door has a plain stone surround with moulded pediment on console brackets. Stone gutter corbels.
